Thriving Families Tool

'It's not what you do, it's the way that you do it!'

In Salford, we believe that in order to tackle neglect, we need to change our language and strengthen our approach in the way we work with children, young people and parents who may be unable to meet their children's needs for some, or all of the time. We want to focus as much on helping families to thrive and in turn reduce the prevalence of childhood neglect.

Neglect is a serious form of harm and learning from case reviews tells us that 'where there are concerns around neglect, all professionals should be supported to use a risk assessment toolkit'.

In Salford to support practitioners and families we have developed the Thriving Families Tool.

The tool aids discussions with families, guides you on what to ask, what to look for and aims to give you more confidence to identify neglect and taking timely action to safeguard children.

Target audience: ALL professionals who work with Salford children, young people, families. This briefing is also relevant to adult focused services.
