Overview

This training looks at real life stories of extremists from both an ERW background and a faith based (Islamist) background. Highlighting how people get involved - the drivers, personal stories and impact of involvement.

Course content:

- Overview of what ERW (Extreme Right-Wing) extremism is
- Overview of what faith-based extremism is
- Lived stories of people involved
- Discussion time for participants to ask trainers about their lived stories and suggestions regarding ways to reduce extremism
- Examples of support needed to assist people to leave extremism
- Specialist support available
