Thriving Families and Neglect

In Salford, we believe that in order to tackle neglect, we need to change our language and strengthen our approach in the way we work with children and parents who may be unable to meet their children's needs for some, or all the time. We want to focus as much on helping families to thrive and in turn reduce the prevalence of childhood neglect.

To support practitioners and families we have developed the Thriving Families and Neglect tool and Views and Voice [Resources](#) to help capture the lived experience of children and improve the quality of their lives including transitions into adulthood.
