



A Child's Lived Experiences Through Care-Proceedings Virtual Training

Overview

This training will explore the child's lived experience when parents/carers are given notice of Pre-Proceedings (the period before court proceedings begin in applications for care orders) as a result of the Local Authority having on-going concerns with the parent's ability to meet the needs of the child or be protective of them. The course will give you the opportunity to explore the important role professionals play before a pre-proceedings letter is sent in creating better experiences and outcomes for children.

The webinar will be delivered in 2 parts and delegates are expected to attend both sessions.

Part 2 will be a reflective session. The reflective session will look at how the training has informed practice. Delegates will be expected to bring real case examples to evidence how practice has changed, look at impact statements that have been written and reflect on how this has impacted on child protection planning.
