Harbour Domestic Abuse Support

Supporting ages 5-18



If you are worried about the impact of domestic abuse on a child or young person, we can help:

Children & Family Support Worker

Providing up to 8 sessions to families who are at the point of separation or who have recently left the abuser, to recover from abuse together and develop positive and healthy relationship.

Providing emotional and practical support and coordinating with external agencies

Trauma Informed Worker

Working with children aged between 5-11 on a 1:1 basis, providing 8 sessions of support around DA, its impacts and a space to express fears or concerns.

Offering direct links into the service for primary schools across Salford

YPVA (Social Care & Sexual Health)

Working with CYP aged 12-18
Offering support at medium and standard risk level. Completing DASH, safety and support plans;

Providing 8 sessions of 1:1 emotional support to understand abuse; completing practical work required and co-ordinating support from external agencies.

Group Facilitator

Delivering the 7 week 'R'Space' group programme to CYP aged 5-14 around DA and it's impacts.

Offering training to professionals, supporting operation encompass and providing domestic abuse awareness workshops in high schools
