In Salford, we have changed our language and strengthened our approach in the way we work with children and parents who may be unable to meet their children's needs for some, or all the time. We are focussing more on helping families to thrive and in turn reduce the prevalence of childhood neglect.

To support practitioners and families we developed the Thriving Families and Neglect tool, Capacity to change guidance and Views and Voice [Resources](#). These developments are to help capture the lived experience of children and improve the quality of their lives including transitions into adulthood.
