# 1 day Child Sexual Abuse Training

### Overview

This one-day introductory course will provide an overview of the key issues needed to support professionals in identifying and responding to cases of intra-familial child sexual abuse (IF-CSA).

**Who should attend?** Staff from all agencies who work with children, young people and families in a professional capacity

### Course aims:

To provide professionals with a better understanding of:

- The scale of the nature of IF-CSA
- How the impact of IF-CSA presents in children and young people
- How and why IF-CSA occurs
- How children communicate their experiences of IF-CSA and how we as professionals support them through the process
