



## Reducing Parental Conflict in the Interest of Improved Outcomes for Children Virtual Course

### Overview

This training is an opportunity for all agencies with little to no training in reducing parental conflict to find out more about this important area of work.

The course is open to anyone who is in a position through a conversation or contact with a family to find out if parental conflict is an issue. Often where other factors are present, such as financial and housing worries, parents may also be struggling with their relationship. Research shows that understanding this and catching it early can make a real difference to a child.

For those of you who work directly with families the course will show you tools and approaches you can use with the family. For those of you who may identify a need and then refer on, the course will cover this, so you know where to go help.

**The training will be delivered in 2 parts and delegates are encouraged to attend both sessions.**

Session 1 will cover the difference between domestic abuse and parental conflict and session 2 will show you the Greater Manchester Relationships Tool Kit.
