- To gain a better understanding of CAPVA (child and adolescent to parent violence and abuse) why it occurs and the impact it has on families.
- To understand how we can best support families affected by CAPVA (child and adolescent to parent violence and abuse) and what options are available to them.
- To understand AIPVA (adolescent intimate partner violence and abuse), why it occurs and how we can promote healthy relationships in adolescents.
- To recognise the services offered by Safe in Salford and how to refer.
