## Who should attend?

Any professional who may be required to engage a family in early help support or who may undertake or contribute to an Early Help Assessment, Team Around the Family (TAF) meeting or Thriving Families Tool.

## **Course Aims/Objectives**

- To consider the qualities and skills required to work in partnership with families
- To reflect on how we engage families to work in partnership and develop a shared understanding
- To consider how we engage families to identify desired change, potential actions and how they will be implemented
- To have knowledge of the tools that can support exploration of a family's strength and needs (Early Help Assessment and Thriving Families Tool)
- To have knowledge of how to review progress and bring the process to an end

## **CHARGING POLICY**

From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 the SSCP has reintroduced the non-attendance charging policy.
