'E-safety Essentials' Intermediate Course

Overview

A journey into the online world which our young people navigate every day.

During this ½ day course you will learn about online risks, how to respond to incidents, and how to encourage young people to be safe online. The course considers what young people are doing online, what we should be looking for and how to practically deliver direct work to children and young people.

- Digital Footprint and Online Reputation (and its relationship with 'Nudes')
- Parental Advice, Content Control, Digital Routines (Contracts, Agreements and Boundaries)
- Delivering direct work around online safety
- Opportunity for Q & A.
