Navigating the impact of trauma at work: professional considerations and self-care

This online workshop is for any frontline staff that work with other people's distress and trauma. Understandably, work like this can take its toll on us, impacting all aspects of our life.

This brief workshop will be an opportunity to consider what some of the risks are and what we can do, both individually and within our teams, to reduce the impact.

The workshop will be led by Dr Kate Friedmann, a Consultant Clinical Psychologist at the Greater Manchester Resilience Hub, working with individuals and teams affected by trauma at work. She is also the clinical lead for the Trusted Relationships service, which supports staff in multi-agency complex safeguarding teams across Greater Manchester.

CHARGING POLICY

From 1st April 2023 the SSCP re-introduced the non-attendance charging policy.
