



Supporting Trans and Gender Variant Children and Young People 1 day Training Course

Overview

The course aims to educate and inform professionals on key terminology that can help themselves as individuals but as organisations to support trans and gender variant young people, the course will also look at issues facing trans young people and what can be done to be more aware.

Who should attend: Staff from all agencies who work with children, young people and families.

Course Objectives:

- What is Gender? Understand the differences between sex and gender, gender expression and identity and transgender and cis gender.
- Understand terminology around gender.
- Supporting trans people: Understand pronouns and the importance, dos and don'ts, organisational responsibility.
- What issues effect trans people
- NHS healthcare pathway
- Modern influencers and resources
- Physical Education – Problems facing Young People.
- Allyship – what can you do? Action planning and policy.
