



Lessons from Case Reviews: Quarter 1 Summary: Cared for Children

What is the event about?

The Salford Safeguarding Children Partnership (SSCP) conduct Local Child Safeguarding Practice Reviews and single and multi-agency learning reviews in line with statutory guidance. All case review activity is overseen by the Practice Review Subgroup (PRSG).

This briefing is about sharing system wide learning across the partnership. To provide frontline practitioners and their managers with an opportunity to come together and reflect on statutory and non-statutory case reviews. It will raise awareness of the thematic areas of safeguarding multiagency practice that we can build upon and strengthen.

There have been a high number of Cared for Children featuring in reviews during 2023-24 so this briefing will be themed specifically around system learning for this cohort of young people, to improve their outcomes.
