



Supporting Trans and Gender Variant Children and Young People 1 day Training Course

Overview

The course aims to educate and inform professionals on key terminology that can help themselves as individuals and as organisations to support trans and gender variant young people, the course will also look at issues facing trans young people and what can be done to be more aware.

Who should attend: Staff from all agencies working with children, young people and families.

Course Objectives:

The training is a full day (9am – 4:30pm), **attendees to arrive at 8:45am for 9am start**. This training features a mix of presentations, videos, discussions, and action planning. The training covers the following learning objectives:

- What is Gender? Understand the differences between sex and gender, gender expression and identity and transgender and cis gender.
- Understand terminology around gender.
- Supporting trans people: Understand pronouns and the importance, dos and don'ts, organisational responsibility.
- What issues effect trans people
- NHS healthcare pathway
- Binders, what is a binder? and binder guide.
- High Court ruling and the impact of this
- Modern influencers and resources.
- What can you do? – Challenging transphobia, policy, visibility, tips and other support
