- Understand the underlying vulnerabilities/risk factors around missing young people
- Have an increased awareness of the GMP Missing Protocol and follow procedures in relation to children/young go missing from home, care and education
- Understand the Missing from Home Service
- Provide advice for parents/carers/children/young people
