What is the event about?

The Salford Safeguarding Children Partnership (SSCP) conduct Local Child Safeguarding Practice Reviews and single and multi-agency learning reviews in line with statutory guidance. All case review activity is overseen by the Practice Review Subgroup (PRSG).

This briefing is about sharing system wide learning across the partnership.
