These questions can help you as professionals gather valuable insights from children and young people and ensure their voices are included in the planning and development of Child Friendly Salford.

GENERAL QUESTIONS

- **What do you like most about your city?**
 - Purpose: To understand the positive aspects of the city from the perspective of young people.
 - Follow-up: Can you describe a specific place or activity that you enjoy?
- **What are some things that could be better about your city?**
 - Purpose: To identify areas for improvement.
 - Follow-up: What changes would make these aspects better for you?
- **What changes would you like to see in your city to make it more child-friendly?**
 - Purpose: To gather suggestions for improvements.
 - Follow-up: How do you think these changes would impact your daily life?
- **Which of these issues we have already found out about are important to you?**
 - Enough places to play or more accessible places to play
 - Work experience to help young people find work
 - Making the city safer for everyone

CREATIVE AND OPEN ENDED QUESTIONS

- **If you were the Mayor for a day, what three things would you change to make the city better for children and young people?**
 - Purpose: To encourage creative thinking and prioritise changes.
 - Follow-up: Why are these changes important to you?
- **Can you draw or describe your ideal child-friendly city?**
 - Purpose: To visualise and articulate their vision.
 - Follow-up: What features are essential in your ideal city?

FOLLOW UP AND REFLECTION

- **How can you help make Salford more child friendly?**
 - Purpose: To reflect on the potential impact of suggested changes.
 - Follow-up: What role do you think young people can play in making these changes happen?
- **How can adults support you in making your city more child-friendly?**
 - Purpose: To identify ways adults can assist.
 - Follow-up: What specific actions can adults take to support your ideas?
