



## SSCP Face to Face Training Early Help Assessment (EHA) and Team Around the Family (TAF)

### Who should attend?

Any professional who may be required to engage a family in early help support, undertake or contribute to an Early Help Assessment (EHA) or coordinate / contribute to a Team Around the Family (TAF) meeting.

### Course Aims/Objectives

- Clarify and explore the meaning of early help and distinguish between the levels of support: 'Getting Help' vs. 'Getting More Help'.
- Explore the skills needed to build strong, collaborative relationships with families.
- Understand how the Early Help Assessment (EHA) supports exploration of strengths and needs.
- Learn how to co-create action plans with families based on their desired changes.
- Understand the purpose of reviewing the Family Plan through Team Around the Family (TAF) meetings.
