

# THE YOUNG PERSON'S PLAN (YPP)

A YPP is here to support you if things aren't going well. It's a way to help you take control of your life with the right support.

WITH THE YPP you choose which adult you feel most comfortable talking to and working with. It could be your social worker, youth worker or teacher.

## WHO IS IT FOR?

You might get a YPP if there are concerns like you are missing school or college, you feel unsafe in the community, or there are worries about where you are or who you are spending time with.
